### <u>CONSULAR FORM FOR A RESIDENT VISA</u> CONSULATE GENERAL OF CHILE TO TOKYO, JAPAN

#### To apply for a Resident Visa:

- 1. Please submit all of the documents listed below, according to the type of Visa that you wish to request. You do NOT have to come personally to the Consulate at this point.
- 2. If you are 18 years of age or older, the Consulate will write a letter requesting the Police to issue a statement that you have no criminal record. In order for you to obtain this document, call the Police Department and ask what specific documents, other than the letter from the Consulate, you need to present. Normally, they will require your passport, your Family Certificate (Koseki), your Address Certificate (Juminhyo) and your personal Seal, if you own one.
- 3. Make an appointment for an interview with the Consul. Bring to this meeting the certificate issued by the Police and your passport. Under certain circumstances, your Visa Request may have to be submitted to Chile for approval.
- 4. The entire procedure to obtain approval takes 4 to 5 weeks, so please make sure that you submit your request no less than one (1) month in advance.
- 5. Sometimes, Visa requests are rejected. In order for us to minimize this risk, please submit to the Consulate all other documents that you may consider useful to support your request.

#### Documents needed to apply for a Student, Labor or Temporary Visa:

- 1. Copy of your entire Passport
- 2. Health Certificate
- 3. Three (3) color passport sized Pictures
- 4. Bank Statement

#### In case of a Student Visa, you also need:

- To present a letter from the school that certifies your enrollment
- To demonstrate that you have the necessary financial means to support yourself while in Chile, such as a scholarship certificate or a notarized letter from your parents stating that they will support you financially during your stay in Chile

In case of a <u>Working Visa</u>, you need to present a notarized original of your employment contract In case of a <u>Temporary Visa</u>, you need to present: the necessary documents that show that you have an immediate family connection to a Chilean national or to someone that has a Resident Visa and lives in Chile; a request letter signed by yourself stating the reasons of your application and the length of your purposed stay; and any certificate that indicates the activity that you will perform

In case of a Visa for a dependent (direct family member), a Family Certificate (Koseki) needs to be presented.

#### To obtain the Visa

while in Chile.

Check with the Consulate on the current cost of the Visa, as it depends on both your nationality and the exchange rate. Once your visa has been approved, the Consulate will contact you. Please pay at the Post Office prior to coming to the Consulate and bring your Passport, as well as the Payment Receipt.
